1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why should a copy of NEMA certification for Garbage Management and Transportation specific to relevant area and garbage collection, segregation and weighing before transportation required before somebody is awarded? One should spend after knowing that you have been awarded.</li> </ul>	A certified copy of NEMA certification for garbage management and transportation specific for the areas of interest MUST be submitted. This should entail garbage collection, segregation and weighing before transportation.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why should one be required to acquire a license from relevant county Government to transport and dump waste to designated site before you are assured of the award considering that these are special groups and they running contract in the area of interest?</li> </ul>	Bidders should strive to obtain this certification for areas they are bidding for. A bidder may attach a certified copy of the certificate if already obtained OR valid evidence that they have applied to obtain the certification.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why should one provide certified labor law compliance certificate in relation to staff remuneration, work injury, benefit policy, NHIF, NSSF remittance while you have not been awarded the contract?</li> </ul>	This requirement is here-by expunged from the technical mandatory requirements but will be required form the winning bidders alongside the performance guarantee before the contract is signed.
