Please confirm the scope of inspection?</p>	<p>Only rig components within the provided scope of works recommended by API for Category III inspections.</p>
3	<p>Kindly confirm in the case of joint venture, if the financial statements of all the companies in the joint venture shall be submitted and evaluated or the financial statements of one of the company in the JV suffices for all</p>	<p>In case of joint venture, the parties to the agreement must be defined with their roles. Where a Fancier is defined his financial statement will be evaluated Otherwise, JV as an entity must ensure they all meet the tender requirement jointly.</p>

	<p>Can inexperienced Kenya company with interest in developing rig inspection local capabilities partner with highly experienced international company that meets all the tender criteria and serve as the Kenyan company's technical partner to deliver the services thereby ensuring capacity development and knowledge transfer to the local company and its staff OR shall the experience of all bidding companies in a JV be subjected to evaluation.</p>	<p>Yes</p>
