KenGen wishes to issue the following additional information on the tender in question through Clarification 1:

	<b>CLARIFICATION</b>	<b>EMPLOYER RESPONSE</b>
1	Is the site visit certificate to be signed by the company (KenGen)?	The Site visit certificate will be signed by KenGen (Project Engineer and Supply Chain)
2	To what extent is the Cultural Centre to be fenced?	Fourteen (14) acres of the Cultural centre will be fenced.
3	Are these two lots one contract or two independent contracts?	The two lots are two independent contracts which can be awarded independently.
4	What is the Employer's position in case of a joint venture	Joint venture will only be allowed for two or more companies <b>all</b> owned by PWD.
5	What is the daily rate charged for unskilled casual labor.	The average rate is Kshs. 500 per person per day. <i>(This figure is for guidance only the bidder will need to negotiate individually with his labour)</i>
6	Who will provide the beacon coordinates	The Engineer will provide the beacon coordinates during setting out.
7	Are there specific locations where gaps are to be left during fencing?	Yes. On river crossings.
8	What is T1, T2 and T3 pipes?	This is explained in the technical specifications section 4.2.4
9	Are there gates to be installed?	Yes. Two gates under lot 2.
10	How will we be accessing the site do we have to pay at the KWS gate?	There will be no payment at KWS gate once the works commence.
11	Will the Engineer give his estimates as per the Act?	The Engineers Estimate for the whole project is about Ksh 60 Million. However bidders are advised to be competitive and no reference to the engineers estimate shall be made in any way during evaluation
12	Is the Contractor to make any access routes?	Provision of access shall be the responsibility of the Employer.

13	Where can the contractor construct the site office?	Site office can be constructed within the site. Security is the responsibility of Contractor. No labour camps are allowed.
14	In the BOQ, item 1.3 the engineers support staff cost is Ksh 1,120,000 yet the overheads & profit are based on a figure of Ksh140, 000. Kindly clarify on the computation.	Interest will be charged on KES. 1,120,000 and not KES 140,000.
15	Is the fence continuous throughout the perimeter of the Rap land area and through the galleys/ streams and rivers?	No. Gaps will be left across river crossing and animal movement corridors. This is captured in the document.
16	We note that intervention is required to secure the integrity of the fence from erosion once installed. For instance, on the Northern and Western side (beacon C-D and D-A in the map provided), there are gullies in excess of 15ft deep. Please explain how the bidder shall mitigate against this.	A provision for rock fill to mitigate against this has been issued in addendum 1.
17	How shall the bidder contain the materials noted in addendum 1 from runoff. In our professional opinion we would need to install gabions and culverts in certain areas.	Refer to addendum 1
