The National Transport and Safety Authority is mandated with issuance of General Dealer License and consequently the Identification Plates pursuant to Section 23 (1) and 24(1) (c) of the Traffic Act.

Through this Notice, the Authority notifies all Dealers, Manufacturers or Repairers of Motor Vehicles or Tow Trucks the commencement of a Licence re-validation exercise scheduled from **1<sup>st</sup> March, 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020**. The objective of this exercise is to ensure compliance and engagement of all stakeholders on the new requirements for licensing.

On completion of the revalidation exercise, the compliant dealers shall be required to make an application for a General Dealer Licence which will qualify them to apply for a renewal identification plates. Garages and towing trucks will be also licensed to enable them access identification plates.
